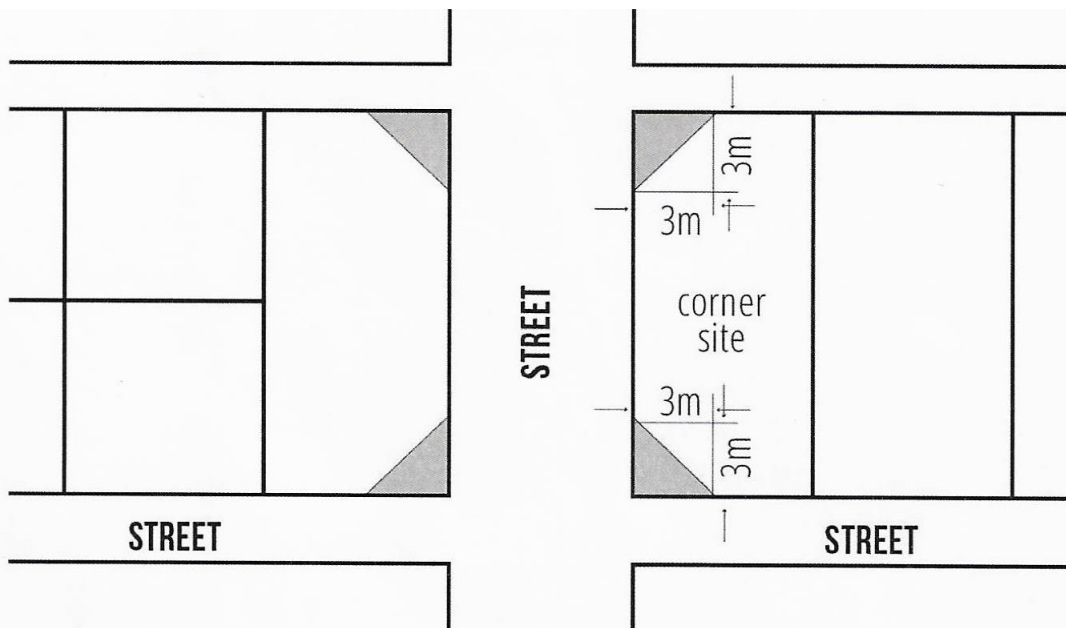
GUIDELINES FOR RESIDENTIAL FENCES

The first step in planning a fence is to prepare a plan of the proposed fence indicating the proximity of the fence to the property line, location of any structure (house, garage, etc.) and the height of the fence. Please ensure that **your fence is built on your property only**.

Fence cannot be encroaching on easement owned by the Village.

The height of any residential fence or similar structure shall not exceed 1.22 metres (4.0 feet) above grade in any front yard or 1.83 metres (6.0 feet) above grade in any side or rear yard.

No fence shall be located in a required sight triangle. No fence, building, structure, vegetation, shall obstruct the vision of drivers within the sight triangle as demonstrated below.



Sight triangles involving a provincial highway or railway shall be determined by the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure (MHI).
