Revenue Collection Update

The Village has seen a strong improvement in outstanding utility balances over the past year. **As of March 31, the total outstanding utility balance is \$2942.07.**

As of March 25, outstanding property taxes total \$83,399.35 across 15 properties. A significant portion of this amount relates to 8 properties currently in tax enforcement, which are projected to be uncollectable and title will be transferred to the municipality. **The remaining 7 properties have a combined outstanding balance of \$17,874.25.**

The Village continues to monitor accounts and proceed with collection and enforcement processes as permitted under legislation.

We appreciate the efforts of residents who have kept their accounts current. For those with outstanding balances, we encourage you to contact the office to make arrangements and avoid service disruptions.

Recycling Changes Coming June 1



The Village of Torquay will be transitioning to the new provincial **SK Recycles** program beginning **June 1, 2026**. This Saskatchewan-wide program shifts more of the recycling costs to producers of packaging and paper products.

Residents will continue to have curbside recycling, with some updates over time such as new guidelines, expanded accepted materials, and potential changes to collection.
