

Interceptors & Traps for Sanitary Sewer System Bylaw Village of Torquay BYLAW NO 2019-01

A BYLAW TO REQUIRE THE INSTALLATION OF INTERCEPTORS AND TRAPS IN THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM.

In accordance with the *National Plumbing Code of Canada*.

The Council of the Village of Torquay in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

No person shall

- a) Discharge or cause to be discharged any storm water, surface water, roof run-off, water from any cooling plant, unpolluted industrial process waters, groundwater or sumps into any sanitary sewer except groundwater from weeping tile drains or industrial cooling water where approved by the Torquay Village council and only where such industrial process or cooling plant water is property metered;
 - b) place, deposit, or permit to be deposited in any manner upon public or private property;
 - i) human or animal excrement;
 - ii) septic tank sludge;
 - iii) greases, oils or sediments from interceptor or trap sumps.

Interceptors

- 2. a) The owner or occupant of any premise which discharges wastewater into the public sanitary sewage system containing fats, oils, grit, grease and is located in a public kitchen, in a restaurant or in a hotel, motel, or multi unit residential home that provides meals, shall discharge through a grease interceptor.
 - where discharge from a fixture may contain oil or gasoline, an oil interceptor shall be installed.
 - ii) where a fixture discharges sand, grit or similar materials, an interceptor designed for the purpose of trapping such discharges shall be installed.
 - b) All such interceptors shall be kept in good working condition at all times and the sump emptied at a frequency sufficient to prevent overloading of the interceptor and overflow of prohibited or restricted wastewater constituents into the public sanitary sewage system.

Enforcement

- 4. a) Any person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction by a fine in an amount not exceeding:
 - ii) Two thousand (\$2,000.00) in the case of an individual;
 - iii) Five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) in the case of a corporation;

or in default of payment by an individual, by imprisonment for a term of not more than thirty (30) days.
